PARTICIPANT RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY FORM

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY! THIS IS A LEGAL DOCUMENT THAT AFFECTS YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS!

This Release and Waiver of Liability (the "Release") executed on or after 8/25/2022, on behalf of the "Participant", releases the California Zoroastrian Center (the "Nonprofit"), a nonprofit organization organized and existing under the laws of the United States as a Section 501(c) (3) tax-exempt corporation, each of its directors, officers, employees, and agents from any liability attributable to the Participant.

I, the parent or guardian of the Participant, do hereby give my consent to the Participant participating in all activities of the Nonprofit in relation to scholastic learning at the Nonprofit. I consent to the Participant engaging in activities related to serving or participating in the Nonprofit's activities as a student, player, or participant. I am responsible for the Participant's own insurance coverage in the event of personal injury or illness as a result of participation in activities of the Nonprofit.

1. **Waiver and Release:** I release and forever discharge and hold harmless Nonprofit and its successors and assigns from any and all liability, claims, and demands of whatever kind or nature, either in law or in equity, which arise or may hereafter arise from the activities of the Participant as a participant with the Nonprofit, including claims arising out of negligence. I understand and acknowledge that this Release Discharges Nonprofit from any liability or claim that I may have against Nonprofit with respect to bodily injury, personal injury, illness, death, or property damage that may result from Participant's involvement in the Nonprofit's activities.
2. **Insurance:** I affirm that the Participant is covered by primary medical insurance and understand that I am responsible for the Participant's medical bills if injury occurs. Further, I understand that Nonprofit does not assume any responsibility for or obligation to provide me with financial or other assistance, including but not limited to medical, health, or disability benefits or insurance of any nature in the event of Participant's injury, illness, death, or damage to our property. I expressly waive any such claim for compensation or liability on the part of Nonprofit beyond what may be offered freely by Nonprofit in the event of such injury or medical expenses incurred by the Participant.
3. **Assumption of Risk:** I understand that the activities provided by the Nonprofit and which Participant is involved may include activities that are inherently dangerous to Participant, including but not limited to surrounding sporting events that Participant may not even be participating in. I hereby expressly assume the risk of injury or harm to Participant from these activities and Release Nonprofit from all liability for injury, illness, death, or property damage resulting from these activities.
4. **Photographic Release:** I grant and convey to Nonprofit all right, title, and interest in any and all photographs, images, video, or audio recordings of Participant or Participant's likeness or voice made by Nonprofit in connection with Participant's involvement in Nonprofit's events, including but not limited to, any royalties, proceeds, or other benefits derived from such photographs or recordings.
5. **Medical Treatment:** I hereby Release and forever discharge Nonprofit from any claim whatsoever which arises or may hereafter arise on account of any first-aid treatment or other medical services rendered in connection with an emergency during Participant's activity with the Nonprofit. I give my consent for the Nonprofit to provide, administer, or obtain medical treatment for the Participant.
6. **Other:** I expressly agree that this Release is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of California and that this Release shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of California. I agree that in the event that any clause or provision of this Release is deemed invalid, the enforceability of the remaining provisions of this Release shall not be affected.

By checking the box and accepting the terms and conditions, I, the parent or guardian of the Participant, express my understanding and intent to enter into this Release and Waiver of Liability knowingly and voluntarily.

تعهدات و مقررات کلاسها و گروه های هنری مرکز زرتشتیان کالیفرنیا

فعالیت های هنری در مرکز زرتشتیان کالیفرنیا به منظور رشد و شکوفایی استعداد های هنری همکیشان برگزار میشود. رعایت مقررات زیر از جانب آموزگاران، هنرجویان، و هنرمندان به گروه هنر کمک میکند تا شرایط مناسب برای تداوم تمام فعالیت های هنری مرکز را ایجاد کند. گروه هنر موظف است در صورت مشاهده نقض مقررات زیر توسط آموزگار یا هنرجو اقدام به تعطیلی کلاس یا اخراج هنرجو از کلاس کند. در صورت اخراج هنرجو شهریه برگشت داده نخواهد شد.

- در صورت اعلام انصراف از کلاس تا یک هفته قبل از شروع کلاس تمام شهریه، بعد از شروع کلاس تا دو جلسه نیمی از شهریه و بعد از دو جلسه شهریه بازگشت داده نمیشود.
- هنرجویان کلاسهای انفرادی موظف اند غیبت موجه خود را از کلاس حداقل 48 ساعت قبل از روز کلاس به اطلاع مدرس برسانند. در غیر این صورت هزینه کلاس را متقبل خواهند شد.
- بر هم زدن نظم کلاس. ایجاد سر و صدای غیر متعارف، دعوا و جر و بحث، شلوغی و مزاحمت برای کلاس های دیگر پذیرفته نیست.
- افراد متفرقه و والدین هنرجویان کلاس ها مجاز به تجمع در راهرو یا کلاسها نیستند.
- نگهداری از تجهیزات آموزشی داخل کلاسها بر عهده آموزگار یا سرپرست گروه و هنرجویان میباشد. در صورت ایجاد خسارت کلیه هزینه ها از گروه دریافت میشود. تخلیه کلاس بعد از زمان آموزش، منظم کردن و برگرداندن کلاس به شکل اول و بستن درب کلاس بر عهده آموزگار و هنرجویان است.
- گروه ها و کلاسهای هنری موظفند در صورت تقاضای مرکز در برنامه های داخلی یا برنامه های سازمان های دیگر به اجرای برنامه بپردازند. این کار با هدف تشویق هنرجویان و بالا بردن توانایی و اعتماد به نفس آنان، آشنایی افراد با فعالیت های هنری مرکز، و تشویق آنان برای شرکت در این فعالیت ها انجام میشود.
- مرکز زرتشتیان مجاز به فیلم برداری و عکس برداری از برنامه ها، و آرایه آنها در رسانه ها میباشد.
- گروه هنر موظف است نیازهای گروه ها و کلاسهای هنری را پیگیری نماید و رابط بین آنها و گروه مدیران مرکز باشد، بنابراین درخواست های خود را با گروه هنر مطرح کنید.

California Zoroastrian Center Art Classes and Groups Rules and Regulations

Art Activities in California Zoroastrian Center are held in order to develop and cultivate artistic talents of Zoroastrians. Observing the underneath regulations would help us maintain the required environment for all art activities in CZC. Art Group is required to suspend any class, or drop any student who disregards these regulations. In that case no refund would be issued.

- In case of withdrawal one week before the first day of the class tuition would be fully refunded, before the third session half of the tuition would be refunded, and after the third session no refund would be issued.
- Students of private classes are required to inform their instructor about their legitimate absence at least 48 hours prior to the class day. Otherwise, they would be charged for that session.
- Lack of discipline, Making unnecessary noise, altercation, and disturbing the other classes are not acceptable.
- Students' parents and unassociated individuals are not allowed to gather in the corridor or classes.
- Instructors, group leaders, and students are held responsible for the equipment in their classes. In case of damage, all costs would be collected from the group. Evacuating the class and returning the class to the initial condition, and closing the class door are the instructor's and students' responsibilities.
- All art Groups and classes are required to perform in the center's internal programs or other institutions' events if requested by CZC. This is aimed to encourage students, improve their abilities and self-esteem, promote the center's artistic activities, and encourage more students to participate in those activities.
- CZC is allowed to photograph and video-record the performances, and publish them on social media.
- The Art Group is required to communicate the requests of the art classes with BOD, and follow-up with their needs. Therefore, feel free to ask the Art Group whenever needed.
